

COVID-19 Symptoms and Free Local Testing Locations

If you have **any** of the symptoms listed in this chart, **PLEASE STAY HOME** and **consider getting tested**

SHOULD I GET TESTED IF I HAVE SYMPTOMS?

Yes. Get tested immediately. Isolate while you wait for your test results and if you test positive.

SYMPTOMS MAY INCLUDE:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Protect yourself and others from the virus that causes COVID-19

- Get vaccinated
- Wear a mask that covers nose and mouth
- Wash hands frequently
- Clean high-touch surfaces often
- Stay at least 6 feet away from others
- Stay home when not feeling well or sick
