Cholesterol screenings

Uninsured students and staff on the Pueblo campus can get free cholesterol screenings between 8:30 am and noon Monday, Nov. 29, in the Davis AB common area. The screenings by a Pueblo County Health Department rep will provide readings for HDL, LDL, triglycerides, total cholesterol and blood glucose levels. Accurate readings require fasting from food or sugary drink at least 2 hours prior to the screening.
