PCC now registering students for 15th annual Kids' College

PUEBLO – Pueblo Community College's popular Kids' College will begin its 15th annual version in June and is now registering students for its two separate schedules – one for kids in grades 1-3 (June 20 to July 1) and the other for those in grades 4 and up (July 11 to July 29). The intent of Kids' College is to provide both a fun and learning experience for youths.

A wide spectrum of courses are offered, ranging from the music, arts & crafts, theater, cooking, baking, outdoor sports and activities, digital photography, robotics, science, astronomy, computers, languages, writing, etc. Morning and afternoon courses are available, with each class length 1½ hours for the younger kids and two hours for the older ones. There is a break from noon to 1 p.m. each day.

Kids' College is organized and conducted by our Community Education and Training Division (CETD). Classes have enrollment limits and are available on a first-register basis.
