<p>New Business (Continued)</p>	<p>Faculty Openings:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A full-time Nurse Aid Program Coordinator is needed on the FCC campus; ADN required. • Full-time nursing faculty are needed on all campuses; MSN required within two years of employment. All full-time positions consist of a 9-month contract paid over 12 months. • A part-time instructor is needed to teach the NUR 201 course (IV Therapy for LPNs). This course runs rarely, on average once every two years. BSN required. <p>State Board Update Regarding Refresher Course</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New State Board rules state that if an applicant has not passed the NCLEX exam after three attempts, they must complete an RN refresher course before retesting.
