**GET ON TRACK**

■ **Apply for scholarships** - Health professions students with a 3.0 GPA or higher are urged to apply for a Kaiser Permanente Safety Net Clinic Scholarship by July 28. Students must agree to work or volunteer at a safety net clinic. The scholarship award covers tuition, fees and books for up to two years.
