## HAPPENINGS

## A FRESH START

■ **Welcome back** - This week the slate is wiped clean as students begin a fresh, new semester at PCC. If you are still enrolling, the GoZone on the Pueblo campus will be open until 5:30 pm Monday through Thursday this week, but you must sign up for any academic and financial aid advising at least one-half hour before closing. The Pueblo campus Cashier's Office has moved to CA-111. You also can pay online through the PCC Portal on the "Student Finance" tab.

■ **Shuttle service** - PCC will provide free golf cart shuttle service from 5 different Pueblo campus locations between the hours of 7:30 am and 8 pm for the first 2 weeks of the Fall Semester.

■ **Get help** - Students, if you have questions about PCC during the first week of classes, stop and inquire at the Info!Zone on the main floor of the Davis AB. It will be staffed from 7:30 am to 6:15 pm Mon - Thur and 7:30 am to 3 pm on Friday. There, you can get:

■ **Cash for books** -You can get some extra cash by selling your used textbooks Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday this week from 9 am to 6 pm (until 5 on Thursday) in the lounge area outside Pueblo Joe's.

■ **ATM machine moving** - With the upcoming renovation of the Student Center, the Higher One ATM located on the first floor of the building will be moved to the Davis AB. It will be unavailable on Monday and Tuesday, (Jan. 16 & 17) during the move. The ATM will be located near the TRiO Student Success Services office and will return to the SC when the renovation is completed.
