The groundbreaking ceremony for the new Learning Center on the Pueblo campus will be held at 10:30 am Monday, Aug. 1, in the basement of the Davis Academic Building near the stairwell. The new LC is being developed to meet our growing enrollment, and it will have 10,000 square feet of space, triple what it currently occupies in AB-150.
