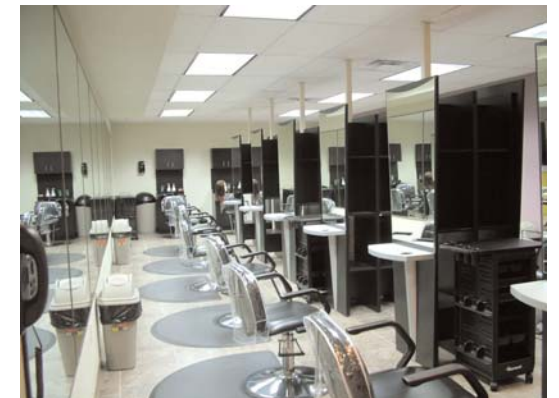
Bongo Ball anyone?
