## **Community can explore PCC's programs during Educational Pathways Fair on Aug. 4**

**PUEBLO** – In today's high unemployment environment, there still are plenty of good jobs available. The key is to acquire the skills needed to qualify for those jobs.

Pueblo Community College wants to tell community members how they can get those skills. On Aug. 4, it will conduct an Educational Pathways Fair from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. in its Fortino Ballroom. The purpose will be help attendees learn about PCC's academic programs and how they can translate into marketable job skills and rewarding careers.

Representatives from all of PCC's certificate and associate degree programs will be available to meet with community members. Enrollment-related reps also will be on hand to help those interested in enrolling at the college. The Fortino Ballroom is on the second floor of the College Center, located at the corner of Orman Avenue and Harrison Street.

Those starting the enrollment process for fall semester classes during the fair will have their registration and assessment testing fees waived, can find out about PCC's transfer opportunities into four-year schools and have their name entered in a drawing for a \$1,000 PCC scholarship. There also will be free refreshments and giveaways for those attending.

PCC's fall semester classes will begin Aug. 22, and registration is currently way. Prior to or after the fair, new students wanting to enroll should start by going to the Go!Zone enrollment desk in the College Center. All new students are required to attend an orientation session.

During the month of August, including the first week of classes, PCC will be open from 8 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday and until 5 p.m. on Fridays. It also will be open from noon to 3 p.m. on Aug. 13.
