### **Wine Tasting Recap**

Bianca noted that total cost of the wine tasting event was approximately \$1851.80 and the approximate revenue was \$1430. The most common compliment that she received was that the guests had fun, and many guests questioned when the next wine tasting event would take place. See attached summary.

Discussion followed regarding Bianca's time spent on the Alumni Association as well as other PCCF events and responsibilities. Joe suggested hiring a temporary employee to help during the times of events. Mary requested a book that would have contact info when planning an event.

Discussion moved to increasing membership. Mary will ask the College's department chairs for two or three names of alumni who would be interested in participating. Mary mentioned that Phi Theta Kappa students are usually more dedicated than others.

### **Fremont Distinguished Alumni**

Mary will meet with Fremont Campus staff, including Dean Jennifer Herman to discuss a possible date for the Fremont Distinguished Alumni luncheon. Joe would like Mary to gather information from the Fremont staff about their Senior Mini College. Discussion followed regarding the AA hosting a distinguished speaker such as a judge, CPA, or attorney to talk about wills. And they spoke about combining this speaker with the Distinguished Alumni Luncheon.

### **Signage**

Mary has received complaints from students on campus that they have a difficult time locating classroom. She would like the AA to sponsor maps that could be framed and posted around campus. Joe thought this may offend the Facilities Department and that the AA should not be involved in College maintenance issues.

### **Other**

Bianca noted that the AA has eight possible events. This number of events is difficult to manage. The events include: Pueblo Distinguished Alumni, Fremont Distinguished Alumni, SCCC Distinguished Alumni, Fremont graduation reception, senior seminar/workshop, Tribute to Alumni Stars, wine tasting, and student recognition at graduation. Bianca noted that the AA should have only two quality events, one held in the spring and one held in the fall.
