Everyone is invited to pay tribute to these students for having turned their lives around by going back to earn their high school diplomas.

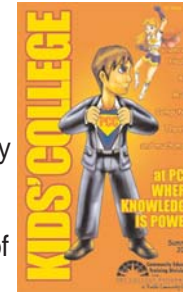
