SHUTTLE SERVICE

■ **Hitch a ride** - Because of PCC's growing enrollment, close-in parking spaces on the Pueblo campus may occasionally be tough to find when Fall Semester classes begin Monday, Aug. 22. To help students make it to their classes on time when having to park in outlying locations, PCC will provide free golf cart shuttle service from 5 different campus locations between the hours of 8 am and 10 pm for the first two weeks of the Fall Semester. Here are the shuttle pickup areas:

- Next to the Health Sciences Annex
- At the corner of the parking lot at Pitkin and Arthur avenues
- From the Harrison Street parking lot entrance nearest the Health Sciences Building
- At the sidewalk next to the entrance to the San Juan parking lot off Marilyn Place
- In the far northwest corner of the GATC parking lot just off Orman Avenue.

Also, work is about to begin on a new parking lot that will be constructed next to the MT Building near the Harrison Street parking lot. The lot is expected to be completed by mid-October. It will add approximately 25 new parking spaces.
