■ **Get registered** - Spring Semester classes will begin Monday, Jan. 16, so don't wait to register. New students should begin by going to the Go/Zone or enrollment center on their specific PCC campus. The enrollment center on the Pueblo campus is open to 5:30 pm Mon-Thurs and until 5 pm thru Jan. 19. The Fremont Campus is open till 6 pm Mon-Thurs and until 5 pm Friday this week. The Fremont Campus will have a special enrollment day from 9 am to 1 pm this Saturday.

**Note that offices on all PCC campuses will not open until 9 am on Tuesday, Jan. 10.**
