Registration now underway for PCC's spring semester

PUEBLO – Following the holiday break, registration has resumed for Pueblo Community College's spring semester, which will begin Jan. 16. Both new and returning PCC students should go to the GoZone enrollment center in the Student Center on the Pueblo campus.

The GoZone is assisting students between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday and until 5 p.m. on Fridays through Jan. 19. There will be a special enrollment and registration day from noon to 3 p.m. this Saturday to assist students.

New students can take care of all of their registration-related needs at the GoZone. These include registering for the College Opportunity Fund, applying for admission and financial aid, meeting with advisors, receiving career counseling and arranging to pay tuition and fees. They also must take basic skills assessment tests.

New PCC students are required to attend an orientation and should schedule a session when registering for classes.

All continuing students should meet with their department advisor, register online and handle administrative functions in the Financial Aid and Admissions & Records offices.

PCC's spring semester includes classes in full-term and half-term sessions. The full term runs from Jan. 16 to May 5, while half terms are from Jan. 16 to March 6 and from March 7 to May 5. Courses are available in daytime and evening hours, and they are offered via traditional classroom means, online, and a combination of online and classroom settings.

At PCC's Fremont Campus in Canon City, advisors are available to help students register for classes between the hours of 8 am to 6 pm, Monday through Thursday and 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Fridays. The Fremont Campus will be open from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. the next two Saturdays (Jan. 7 and Jan. 14).
