COLLEGE NOTES

■ **Register** - This is a great time to register for the Spring 2012 Semester and get that done before the break. PCC campuses will be open thru Dec. 23, then will shut down from Dec. 24 to Jan. 2 before re-opening on Tuesday, Jan. 3. The Spring class schedule is available on the PCC website.

■ **New students** - New students should begin by going to the Go/Zone or enrollment center on their specific PCC campus. New students are required to attend an orientation, and 3 sessions are scheduled in January on the Pueblo campus -- Friday, Jan. 6; Saturday, Jan. 7; and Wednesday, Jan. 11. All sessions will run from 9 am to 2 pm and will start in the Fortino Ballroom. Sign up when registering for your classes.

■ **Go/Zone hours** - In order to improve efficiency in the Go/Zone on the Pueblo campus, students will need to sign in by 4:30 pm for Advising or Financial Aid services thru Friday, Dec. 23.

Extended hours for the Go/Zone (8-5:30 M-Th and 8-5 F) will begin on Jan. 3 and will end on Jan. 19. There will be a special enrollment and registration day 12-3 pm on Saturday, Jan. 7.

■ **D2L training** - As an aid to students, PCC has scheduled two Desire2Learn (D2L) training sessions at the start of the Spring Semester to show students how to maneuver in D2L. The sessions are scheduled for:

- **Friday, Jan. 20: 9-10 am**
- **Monday, Jan. 23: 12-1 pm**

Both sessions will be held in the new Learning Center in the basement of the Davis Academic Building. No pre-training signup is needed -- just show up for the session. Yes, they are FREE.
