■ **Avoid the chaos** - PCC's fall semester will begin on Monday, Aug. 22, and registration is under way on all PCC campuses. Don't wait to go thru the enrollment process and register for your classes. The longer you wait, the less chance of getting the classes you want and the busier the enrollment centers will be as the semester nears.

■ **Apply for scholarships** - Health professions students with a 3.0 GPA or higher are urged to apply for a Kaiser Permanente Safety Net Clinic Scholarship by July 28.
