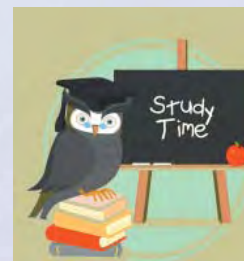
....one mistake can last a lifetime. **Spring Break** begins **Monday, March 23**; classes resume **Monday March 30**.
