3 new PCC scholarships

PCC will make an education more affordable this fall semester by offering 3 new scholarships for the 2011-2012 academic year:

- **Merit based** - For graduating high school seniors with a 3.2 or higher cumulative GPA (deadline June 3)
- **First generation** - For graduating high school seniors for which neither parent has earned a four-year degree or beyond (deadline June 3)
- **Nontraditional** - Over 25 years old, must be a new student fall 2011 (deadline August 12)

There will be up to eight \$500 awards for all three scholarships for the fall and spring semesters. These scholarships are open to students at all PCC campus sites, and information is available in the Go!Zone / enrollment center on your respective PCC campus.
