

**Career Opportunities**

The EMS program prepares you for a career in the pre-hospital health care field as an Emergency Medical Technician at either the EMT, EMT- Intermediate, or Paramedic level. Career opportunities include ambulance service, fire service, tactical EMS, critical care transport, and emergency department technician. If you graduate with an AAS degree, you have additional career opportunities in administration and management in the pre-hospital field.

**Program Requirements**

*Entrance requirements:*

To enroll in all EMS programs, you must be at least 18 years of age, have all current immunizations, pass a background check and a drug screen and be able to meet the requirements of the Functional EMS Job Description.
