### Pharmacy Technician Certificate

Pharmacy Technician (PHT) certificate program is offered in one-semester. It provides instruction in basic pharmacy theories and is an important step toward national certification as a pharmacy technician. Learning experiences include lecture, lab, and clinical exposure in local pharmacies. To ensure success in this program, you should have a good knowledge of basic algebra and math formulas.

The PHT program has a selective admissions process. The program application and requirements are available in the Health & Public Safety office or at [Pueblo Community College PHT](#) May 1 to July 15. All Health & Public Safety programs have essential functions to help you be successful in the program and career.

**Note:** You must undergo a background check and drug screen before we can officially admit you into the program. A felony, loss of license, administrative disciplinary proceeding for negligence, malpractice, recklessness, or willful or intentional misconduct may prohibit entrance into the program and/or eligibility to sit for licensure exams.
