Semester Milestones

Always complete courses with a grade of C or higher.

Fall 1st Year

1) Complete FAFSA for next academic year when registering for spring semester.

Spring 1st Year

1) Complete scholarship applications for next academic year. 2) Register for summer and fall semesters. 3) If you plan to enroll in any summer classes, submit Summer Intent Form to Financial Aid Office for funding. 4) Check on your portal to make sure your Financial Aid for next year is processed. If so, you will be able to accept your award offer.

Fall 2nd Year

1) Meet with your advisor to complete your Graduation Planning Sheet; 2) Register for spring semester. 3) Apply for Admission to C S U P. 4) Complete FAFSA for next academic year when registering for spring semester.

Spring 2nd Year

1) Tour C S U P, visit the campus to meet your new Advisor, check on your financial aid, apply for scholarships, register for classes, and register for a New Student Orientation. 2) Graduate from PCC!!
