## Southwest Colorado Community College and the Cortez Recreation Center

Have joined together to provide students at the SCCC Mancos campus with the opportunity to benefit from student activity fees paid both Spring and Fall semesters by SCCC Mancos students. Activity fees paid by SCCC Mancos students for six or more credit hours taken at the SCCC Mancos campus site contribute toward general membership into the Cortez Recreation Center. Each semester eligible students are identified AFTER census date. Students taking 6 credits or more become eligible for up to 15 visits throughout the semester term. ### DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY BENEFIT AND CONDITIONS

SCCC-West/ Mancos is happy to introduce a partnership with the Cortez Recreation Center.

Students taking 6 or more credits at the **Mancos** campus will be eligible for 15 visits to the Cortez Recreation Center.

The following conditions apply:

- Eligible students receive 10 visits
- The 15 visits are for general admission to the Cortez Recreation Center only.
- To be eligible, students must be enrolled in 6 credits or more AT the Mancos campus to qualify. Online classes and courses taken at the SCCC Durango Campus DO NOT APPLY.
- Eligible students must go to the GoZone and get your official SCCC-West/ Mancos Student ID card. This student ID was covered by student fees so no additional cost is required for the issuance of your first card. Lost or stolen replacement card fees may apply.
- This ID card is the only way students will be able to redeem the 10 visits to the Cortez Recreation Center.
- Eligible students will only be able to go to the Cortez Recreation Center. The Durango Recreation Center does not apply.

### BENEFIT AND CONDITIONS

- The 15 visits are valid to eligible students starting September 15 through January 16, 2014– Fall 2014 semester ONLY. Eligibility for the Fall 2014 semester will begin after the Fall 2014 Census date. There are NO summer Recreation Center visits available for summer courses .. yet...
- You must have your SCCC-West/ Mancos ID to enter the Cortez Recreation Center. Your ID will be matched by your picture and your name on an eligibility list each semester. No ID, No Entrance ... No exceptions.
- Any manipulations of the above conditions will result in the suspension of the eligibility of a student to access to the Cortez Recreation Center for the remainder of the semester. Three or more violations and a student becomes permanently ineligible for the benefit.
- This is a non-transferrable benefit. It is just for you!
- Just follow the rules and enjoy the Center.
