## SHOULD I GET TESTED IF I HAVE SYMPTOMS?



Yes. Get tested immediately. Isolate while you wait for your test results and if you test positive.

### SYMPTOMS MAY INCLUDE:



• Fever or chills



• Cough



• Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing



• Fatigue



• Muscle or body aches



• Headache



• New loss of taste or smell



• Sore throat



• Congestion or runny nose



• Nausea or vomiting



• Diarrhea
